2024 Dual Vision: Art Through Different Eyes
Rules and Guidelines for Guild Members

Here are the governing Rules and Guidelines, as well as key dates. By participating in Dual Vision, you acknowledge these Rules and Guidelines and agree to comply with them.

Photo Selection—May 10, 2024 10:00 a.m. to noon

- We will **select our photos** at the **May 10** Photo Selection at **The Artisans Village’s Livery Studio** located at **109 E. Marion Street, Eatonton between 10:00 and noon**. First come, first served. Please select no more than 2 photos and please take only photos from which you will create work. If you take a photo and do not use it, no one else will be able to create art inspired by that photo. Each photo can only be selected by one artist.
- If you are a Guild member photographer and want to offer photos at the Photo Selection, please let Linda Foster (lbfooster@outlook.com) know and bring your photos to the Selection on May 10. If any of your photos are chosen, they will be taken away by the artists that day. They will be returned to you in late August. You will be obligated to provide a matted 8x10 copy of the photo for the September reveal and the reception/exhibition in Barrel and the Gallery. You will be sent the Photographers’ Rules and Guidelines and must comply with those, also.
- Photographers grant use of their photo(s) only to the Guild Member who selects them and only for purposes of creating art for Dual Vision and any subsequent display or sale of that specific piece of art. Unless the Guild Member obtains permission from the photographer, the Guild Member cannot use the photo(s) for creating additional art pieces or any other purpose.
- Please take good care of the photo(s) you select. You must return that photo to the photographer by August 31, so they can prepare it for the Reveal and Reception. If you are worried that you will damage the photo, talk to the photographer about getting another copy. You will be supplied by email with contact information for the photographer(s) whose photo(s) you select.
- If you are unable to attend the Photo Selection meeting and still want to participate, please let us know. We will have a list of photographers who are willing to work with you. We strongly recommend that you attend the May 10 Selection meeting for the best range of choices. If you choose a photo after Selection day, please let Linda Foster (lbfooster@outlook.com) know as soon as possible so our records are complete.

Creating Artwork Inspired by the Photo(s) You Select

- You can create any medium of art that the photo(s) inspires in you. However, no artificial intelligence (AI) generated artwork will be accepted in the show.
- Paintings cannot be wider than 46 inches or taller than 60 inches when framed.
- For paintings, you must either: (1) paint on a gallery wrapped canvas (at least 1 3/8’ inch return) that you have painted on the sides and **wired for hanging**; or (2) frame the piece and **wire it**. Please use coated wire and do not tie a knot in the wire in case those hanging the show need to shorten or lengthen your wire. **No saw tooth hangers**.
- For 3D Design work, please remember that it will have to be displayed at Barrel 118 and in the Gallery. If it can be hung, it must be wired (Please use coated wire and do not tie a knot in the wire in case those hanging the show need to shorten or lengthen your wire.) If it needs to be displayed on a table

or shelf, it must either sit on its own or you will have to supply a means for it to stand up. Please, nothing that weighs more than one hundred pounds.

- All artwork and photos must be for sale. Sales of your work will carry a 35% commission to the Gallery. Price your work to take the commission into consideration.

The Big Reveal—Friday September 13, 2024 10:00 a.m. to noon

- Please bring your completed artwork to the September 13 Guild meeting at 10:00 a.m. at The Peoples Bank, Lake Oconee Branch for the Big Reveal. You will stand with the photographer whose photo inspired you and share your inspiration with the group.

Drop off Artwork—Friday September 13, 2024 (1-5) or Saturday September 14, 2024 (10-3)

- Artwork must be delivered to Barrel 118 located at 118 N. Jefferson Ave, Eatonton GA on Friday September 13 between 1:00 and 5:00 or Saturday September 14 between 10:00 and 3:00. Please do not take your artwork to the Gallery.

Dual Vision Reception—Thursday September 19, 2024 5:00 to 7:30

- **The Dual Vision Reception will be Thursday September 19 from 5:00 to 7:30 at historic Barrel 118 located at 118 N. Jefferson Ave, Eatonton, GA 31024.** The reception is **free and open to the public.** Complimentary wine and refreshments will be served. Cocktails and beer will be offered for sale. Bring your friends and family and vote for Peoples Choice for favorite photo and favorite artwork.
- You can see the show at Barrel 118 on Friday September 20 from 11-5 and Saturday September 21 from 10-3. After September 21, the Guild will move the show to the Gallery where it will be on display through October 31. (Gallery hours: Wednesday-Friday 11-5 and Saturday 10-3).

Pick Up Artwork—Friday November 1, 2024 (11-5) or Saturday November 2, 2024 (10-3)

- You will pick up your art on Friday November 1 (11-5) or Saturday November 2 (10-3) from the Gallery.
- All Dual Vision participants agree to the use of their photos and artwork submitted for the show in marketing by The Artisans Village, The Artisans Village Guild, The Artisans Village Art Gallery, Barrel 118, Goin' Artistic, LLC, and the Associated Photographers of Lake Oconee.
- Reasonable measures will be exercised with all artwork and photos. The Artisans Village Guild, The Artisans Village Art Gallery, Barrel 118, Goin' Artistic, LLC, Associated Photographers of Lake Oconee and their board members, officers and volunteers will not be responsible for loss or damage of artwork while in transit, storage, display or left after the pickup date. Guild member agrees not to hold liable The Artisans Village, The Artisans Village Guild, The Artisans Village Art Gallery, Barrel 118, Goin' Artistic, LLC, Associated Photographers of Lake Oconee and their board members, officers and volunteers for any accident or injury, or any damage, loss or theft that may occur to artwork or photos.
- The Artisans Village Guild and The Artisans Village Art Gallery reserve the right to refuse for any reason to display any artwork submitted.
