2024 Rules and Regulations

Each artist must sign the third page of this list of Rules and Regulations prior to participation in the Eatonton One Day Paint Out. By signing, the artist agrees to comply with these Rules and Regulations. Bring this document with you. Organizers will retain the third page the day of the event.

1. Artist must be 18 years of age or older.
2. Registration is \$20. Registration may be made: **(a)** by mailing the attached registration form to Treasurer, 123 Smith Court, Eatonton, GA along with a check for \$20 made payable to TAVG; **(b)** online at <https://theartisansvillage.org/eodpo-2024/> or **(c)** the day of the event. **Early registration will ensure that you receive updates and emailed information about the event.** At the event bring cash or check. If you have any difficulty, contact Linda Foster at lfoster@outlook.com.
3. The event will be held rain or shine, so come prepared.
4. On the day of the event and prior to starting to paint, artist must submit **blank** canvases or other substrates to the event organizers at The Artisans Village Art Gallery located at 110 W. Marion St, Eatonton, GA 31024. Organizers will place a stamp on the back side of the canvas(es) or other substrate(s). Paintings without stamps will not be accepted for judging. Do not obscure the stamp when painting.
5. Artist may pre-glaze the canvas(es) or substrate(s) in a solid color prior to presentation to organizers for stamping. No other marks may be made on the canvas(es) prior to 1:00 p.m. the day of the event.
6. Artist must begin the painting(s) **at or after 1:00 p.m.** the day of the event.
7. Artist must submit the painting to event organizers at The Artisans Village Art Gallery located at 110 W. Marion St, Eatonton, GA **by 5:00 p.m.** the day of the event. **No work can be done after 5:00 p.m.**
8. Artist should paint outdoors within one mile of the registration location (110 W. Marion St, Eatonton, GA).
9. Artist's name, artwork title and date should be legibly printed on the back of the submitted artwork.
10. Entries using manipulated photographic processes, stencils, computer enhanced imagery or other non-*plein air* means will not be accepted.

11. Artist is urged to frame work submitted for judging. Bring appropriately sized frames with you along with tools necessary to frame work.
12. The Artisans Village Art Gallery will retain 35% of any and all sale proceeds for artwork produced at the event and sold at the event or at the exhibition at The Artisans Village Art Gallery.
13. Checks for sale of artwork will be mailed after the event.
14. Winner of the event agrees to release the copyright of their entry solely for use in future Eatonton One Day Paint Out events.
15. Artist agrees to the use of images of artist participating in and artwork produced during Eatonton One Day Paint Out for event publicity (website, posters, advertisements, etc...)
16. Artist agrees to respect both private property owners by securing permission to go onto their property and public lands by following any applicable laws.
17. For judging, artist is encouraged to bring a frame(s) with a wire on the back or to paint the return on the canvas(es) or use a substrate(s) that does not require a frame.
18. Judging is final and non-contestable. At organizers' discretion depending on participation, prizes of \$150 for 1st place, \$100 for 2nd place and \$75 for 3rd place will be awarded.
19. Winners of the Eatonton One Day Paint Out agree to display for sale the winning paintings in The Artisans Village Art Gallery located at 110 W. Marion Street, Eatonton, GA 31024, from May 4 to July 6, 2024.
20. Artist may display for sale framed, wired artwork produced at the event in The Artisans Village Art Gallery located at 110 W. Marion Street, Eatonton, GA 31024, from May 4 to July 6, 2024
21. If Artist chooses to display paintings at The Artisans Village Art Gallery, the artist must supply a frame(s) with a wire or paint the return on the canvas(es) (which must be at least 1 ½ inch deep) and add a wire or use a substrate(s) that does not require a frame, but has a wire.
22. Artist must pick up paintings displayed at The Artisans Village Art Gallery located at 110 W. Marion Street, Eatonton, GA 31024, by Saturday July 6, 2024 unless other arrangements are made with Gallery Manager.

Topics will include how to compose on site and how to get the most out of your materials. Material lists will be provided in advance. We will have indoor accommodations in the event of inclement weather.

Celeste McCollough (oil/acrylic)

Celeste McCollough's work has been collected throughout the United States and in Europe. She has exhibited in numerous national shows and has received multiple awards. An upbringing in rural Georgia followed by a full career and life in the city have given Celeste an appreciation for every type of subject – cityscapes, landscapes, and peplescapes. Her irresistible urge to observe keeps her eye and brain engaged as she seeks to express in paint what she experiences in life.

Representative national shows: Olmsted Plein Air International; Impressionist Society of America; National Oil and Acrylic Painters; Oil Painters of America; Pastel Society of America.

Shane McDonald (oil/acrylic)

Shane McDonald has created fine art oil and pastel portraits for patrons throughout the Southeast since obtaining his BA degree in Art from Kennesaw State University in 1992. His training in classical drawing and painting paired with his willingness to embrace the current trends in contemporary art has enabled him to maintain respect as

a fine artist and instructor in the Atlanta area. Having served the art community as a mentor for youngsters by teaching and demonstrating at schools, as a facilitator of art critiques and open studio figure drawing groups, and as a leader for arts organizations, Shane lives his life around art. Currently Shane's fine art landscapes are represented by Robert Kent Gallery in Marietta, GA. Figurative works and still-life paintings can also be seen in his commercial studio and gallery in at the Artisan Resource Center in Marietta, GA. Proficiency in diverse subject matter and media has also enabled Shane to create masterful murals in public institutions and private residences, but his name is best known for his exquisite portraits in oil and pastel.

Shane has won numerous awards for his works at juried competitions. His paintings are in the permanent collections at the Marietta/Cobb Museum of Art, Kennesaw State University, and the Zuckerman Museum of Art.
