Rules and Guidelines for Associated Photographers of Lake Oconee and Guild Member Photographers

Here are the governing Rules and Guidelines, as well as key dates. By participating in Dual Vision, you acknowledge these Rules and Guidelines and agree to comply with them.

Photo Selection Day-May 10, 2024 10:00 a.m. to noon

- The Artisans Village Guild invites the APLO members and Guild Member photographers to bring photos to the May 10 Photo Selection at the Guild 's monthly meeting at The Artisans Village's Livery Studio located at 109 E. Marion Street, Eatonton. Selection will be from 10:00 to noon. You may set up starting at 9:30.
- A photo may only be selected by one Guild member so we do not have more than one piece of art inspired by a single photo. We tell Guild members this rule, but need the photographers to help us police this rule.
- Photographers grant use of their photo(s) only to the Guild Member who selects them and only for purposes of creating art for Dual Vision and any subsequent display or sale of that specific piece of art. Unless the Guild Member obtains permission from the photographer, the Guild Member cannot use the photo(s) for creating additional art pieces or any other purpose.
- Guild members will take the photo with them that day. Guild members are asked to safeguard your photos. Guild members are asked to contact their photographers to return photos no later than August 31 to give photo club members plenty of time to mat them for display.
- On selection day, we record each Guild members selection. You will receive an email listing the photos selected and the selecting Guild member's name and email address. We will share your contact information with the selecting Guild member, so they can contact you return the photo or with any questions. Even if you do not want to number or name your photos prior to the selection day, please mark the selected photos in some way so we can identify the photo for our records.
- Some Guild members may not be able to attend Selection day. Please let Linda Foster know if you are
 willing to be on a list of photographers who are willing to work with Guild members post selection day
 to choose a photo. If a Guild member selects one of your photos post selection day, please let Linda
 Foster (lbfoster@outlook.com) know as soon as possible.

The Big Reveal—Friday September 13, 2024 10:00 a.m. to noon PLEASE NOTE CHANGE OF LOCATION

 Participating APLO members are invited to The Artisans Village Guild 's September Guild meeting at BARREL 118, 118 N. Jefferson Ave, Eatonton, GA on September 13, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. for the Dual Vision Reveal. Please note the change in location—the Reveal will NOT be at the bank. Photo club members will need to bring their photos that were selected to the Reveal. You will stand with the Guild Member whose artwork your photo inspired and share your inspiration with the group.

Drop off photos—Friday September 13, 2024 (noon to 4:00) or Saturday September 14, 2024 (10-2) REVISED

- Photos must be delivered to Barrel 118 located at 118 N. Jefferson Ave, Eatonton GA on either Friday September 13 (location of the Reveal) beginning at noon Friday September 13, 2024 until 4:00 or Saturday September 14, 2024 between 10:00 and 2:00. This is the same location as the Reveal. There will be NO drop off processing until we complete the Reveal.
- All photos must be for sale and the Gallery manager is happy to facilitate multiple sales of the same photo if you will make more copies or offer photos in different sizes. Sales of your work will carry a 35% commission to the Gallery. Take that commission into consideration when you price your work. In the past, photos have been priced anywhere from \$15 to over \$100. Pricing is your decision.
- For the Reception and Exhibition, all photos should be 8x10 and must be matted (to no larger than11x14). No frames. The mat must be secured on all four sides. The color of the mat is your decision. However, photos matted in white tend to not stand out well when displayed on our Gallery white pallets and walls. Please put your name and the photo's title on the back of the mat.
- Only photos from which artwork was created will be displayed in the show.

Dual Vision Reception—Thursday September 19, 2024 5:00 to 7:30

- The Dual Vision Reception will be Thursday September 19 from 5:00 to 7:30 at historic Barrel 118 located at 118 N. Jefferson Ave, Eatonton. The reception is free and open to the public.
 Complimentary wine and refreshments will be served. Cocktails and beer will be offered for sale.
 Bring your friends and family and vote for Peoples Choice for favorite photo and favorite artwork.
- You can see the show at Barrel 118 on Friday September 20 from 11-5 and Saturday September 21 from 10-3. After September 21, the Guild will move the show to the Gallery where it will be on display through October 31. (Gallery hours: Wednesday-Friday 11-5 and Saturday 10-3).

Pick Up Photos—Friday November 1, 2024 (11-5) or Saturday November 2, 2024 (10-3)

- Please mark your calendars to pick up your photos from the Gallery (a reminder will be sent) Friday
 November 1 between 11-5 or Saturday November 2 between 10-3.
- All Dual Vision participants agree to the use of their photos and artwork submitted for the show in marketing by The Artisans Village, The Artisans Village Guild, The Artisans Village Art Gallery, Barrel 118, Goin' Artistic, LLC, and the Associated Photographers of Lake Oconee.
- Reasonable measures will be exercised with all photos and artwork. The Artisans Village Guild, The
 Artisans Village Art Gallery, Barrel 118, Goin' Artistic, LLC, Associated Photographers of Lake Oconee
 and their board members, officers and volunteers will not be responsible for loss or damage of artwork
 or photos while in transit, storage, display or left after the pickup date. Photographer agrees not to
 hold liable The Artisans Village, The Artisans Village Guild, The Artisans Village Art Gallery, Barrel 118,
 Goin' Artistic, LLC, Associated Photographers of Lake Oconee and their board members, officers and
 volunteers for any accident or injury, or any damage, loss or theft that may occur to artwork or photos.
