The Artisans Village Guild 2023 Dual Vision: Art Through Different Eyes Guidelines for Guild Members Updated 3/24/23

Here are a few guidelines and dates to keep in mind:

- If you are a guild member photographer and want to offer photos, please bring your photos to include in the selection process. If any of your photos are chosen, they will be taken away by the artists that day. They will be returned to you in late August. You will be obligated to provide a matted 8x10 copy of the photo for the September reveal and the reception/exhibition in the Gallery.
- We will select our photos at the April 14 Photo Selection at our monthly Guild meeting at The Artisans Village's Livery Studio located at 109 E. Marion Street, Eatonton between 10:00 and noon. First come, first served. Please select no more than 2 photos and please take only photos from which you will create work. If you take a photo and do not use it, no one else will be able to create art inspired by that photo. Each photo can only be selected by one artist.
- Please contact your photographer before August 31 to return the photo if you have a physical photo from them. This will allow our photographers sufficient time to have their photos matted and prepared for the Reception and Exhibition. The photographers will bring the photos to our September 8 Guild meeting.
- Please bring your artwork to the **September 8 Guild meeting** at 10:00 a.m. at The Peoples Bank, Lake Oconee Branch for the Big Reveal.
- Artwork must be delivered to Barrel 118 located at 118 N. Jefferson Ave, Eatonton GA on Friday September 8 between 1:00 and 5:00 or Saturday September 9 between 10:00 and 3:00.
- Please note that you do not deliver your artwork to the Gallery as you have in the past.
- The Dual Vision Reception will be Thursday September 14 from 5:00 to 7:30 at large, beautiful and historic Barrel 118 located at 118 N. Jefferson Ave, Eatonton, GA 31024. The reception is free and open to the public. Complimentary wine and refreshments will be served. Cocktails and beer will be offered for sale. Bring your friends and family and vote for Peoples Choice for favorite photo and favorite artwork.
- Please note that the Reception is not at the Gallery this year.
- The Exhibition and Sale will be displayed through Saturday September 16 at Barrel 118. Hours are Friday 11-6 and Saturday 10-3. What a fun, beautiful place to bring friends and family.
- The Exhibition and Sale will be moved to The Artisans Village Art Gallery and Gifts, located at 110 W. Marion Street after September 16 and will be displayed through Friday October 27, 2023. Hours are Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 11-6; Saturday 10-3.
- You will pick up your art on Friday October 27 (11-5) or Saturday October 28 (10-3) from the Gallery.
- You can create any medium of art that the photo(s) inspires in you.
- Please take good care of the photo(s) you select. You must return that photo in late August (date to be announced). If you are worried that you will damage the photo, talk to the photographer about getting another copy.

- Size-wise, remember that it will be one of many pieces of artwork and photos. The photos are on display next to the work that they inspired. Paintings cannot be wider than 46 inches or taller than 60 inches when framed.
- If you do a painting, you must either: (1) do it on a gallery wrapped canvas (at least 1 3/8' inch return) that you have painted on the sides and wire it for hanging or (2) frame it and wire it. Please use coated wire and do not tie a knot in the wire in case those hanging the show need to shorten or lengthen your wire. No saw tooth hangers.
- If you do some type of 3D Design work, please remember that it will have to be displayed at Barrel 118 and in the Gallery. If it can be hung, it must be wired (Please use coated wire and do not tie a knot in the wire in case those hanging the show need to shorten or lengthen your wire.) If it needs to be displayed on a table or shelf, it must either sit on its own or you will have to supply a means for it to stand up. Please, nothing that weighs more than one hundred pounds.
- All artwork and photos must be for sale. Sales of your work will carry a 35% commission. Price your work to take that into consideration.
- If you are unable to attend the photo selection meeting and still want to participate, please let us know. We will have a list of photographers who are willing to work with you. We strongly recommend that you attend the meeting, however, since the broadest selection of photos will be available there.
