EXHIBITION DATES: May 11 to July 6, 2023

ENTRIES DEADLINE: March 30

ELIGIBILITY: The exhibition is open to all artists 18 years or older. Painting, Drawing, Print Making and 3-D Design. No Giclees, photocopy, photographs or mechanically produced prints.

Work created under supervision, classwork/workshops or with patterns (unless created by the artist) is not permitted.

All work must be original and all stages created entirely by the artist, including any photographs used. Artists are permitted to use their own photos if taken by themselves as reference materials in the creation of their artwork, but not photos from other sources, even with permission.

Work previously displayed in any of The Artisans Village Guild Shows or The Artisans Village Art Gallery is not eligible.

All work must have been created in the past 2 years.

AWARDS: \$750 First Place, \$500 Second, \$250 Third and \$100 Peoples Choice. \$100 Merit Awards may be given. Awards will be presented at the opening reception May 11.

JUROR/JUDGE: Lauren Adams

Lauren Adams is a Southern artist based in Atlanta who has concentrated on painting and drawing most of her life. Her work runs the gamut from contemporary realism and landscape to abstract painting. Lauren holds a BFA in illustration and MFA in painting from Savannah College of Art and Design. She owned a successful decorative painting business for fifteen years. Her work is included in public and private collections throughout the Southeast, including the Medical College of Georgia in Augusta and the Historical Society of Sandersville.

ENTRY AND FEES: You do not have to be a member of TAVG to enter but we encourage you to do so with your application form at the theartisansvillage.org. For members, the entry fee is \$30 for three submissions. For non-members, the entry fee is \$50 for 3 submissions. You may submit 3 but not more than 2 entries may be accepted. All entries must be completed and fees received no later than midnight March 30 . All entries must be in JPEG format and all images must be entered as image only. NO background or frames for 2-D and a plain, neutral background for 3-D. Digital files should be saved in jpeg format and should be between 1400 pixels and 4000 pixels on its longest side. 3-D design entries may submit 2 images for each piece. Please include the artist's name and title of work on each JPEG entered.

SIZE: For all 2 dimensional work, a maximum of 1200 square inches, (30X40=1200). If the piece is framed it may not exceed a width of 46", a height of 60" or a depth of 3". Minimum: 35 square inches, image. Gallery wrap must not be less than 1-3/8" nor more than 3" deep and finished on all sides, either as an extension of the painting image or solid black.

For 3 dimensional work: Maximum 36" width and 72" height, not including additional base or pedestal which is not part of the the work but necessary for display. One hundred pounds each maximum for artwork and base. No installations.

FRAMING: All 2 dimension work must be framed in gallery quality wood frames and wired ready for hanging. Gallery wrap is acceptable if properly presented. No sawtooth hangers. Watercolors, pastels, drawings and anything on paper must be framed and protected under glass,

plexiglass or other protective covering. ONLY white or off/ white (neutral) mats should be used.

No wet paint will be accepted.

All work must have the following information printed on the back (or bottom for 3D): Artist's Name and Title.

ALL ART MUST BE FOR SALE

COMMISSION: The artist will receive 60 percent of the sale price, the hosting gallery will retain 35 percent and TAVG will retain 5 percent of all sales. All artwork is subject to payment of the 40% commission once it is entered.

DELIVERY OF WORK: Work must be hand delivered to **Barrel 118, 118 N. Jefferson, Eatonton, GA 31024** on May 5-6 between 11 AM and 3 PM.

TAVG reserves the right to refuse to display and/or allow judging due to: technical inaccuracies, misrepresentation or inadequate framing/presentation.

PUBLICITY: Artists consent to having reproduction of their work used for promotional purposes. Artist reserves copyright.

RETURN OF ARTWORK: ALL artwork must be picked up **July 7-8 b**etween the hours of 10AM and 3PM at the Artisans Village Gallery. No work may be removed before the show closes. The gallery will not be responsible for work left beyond these dates.

LIABILITY: Every reasonable measure of care will be exercised with all artwork. The Artisans Village Guild and The Artisans Village Art Gallery will not be responsible for loss or damage of artwork while in transit, storage, display or left after the pick up date.
