- We invite all photo club members to bring photos to the April 14 Photo Selection at the Guild 's monthly meeting at The Artisans Village's Livery Studio located at 109 E.
 Marion Street, Eatonton. Please note it is not at the bank. Selection will be from 10:00 to noon. You may set up starting at 9:30. We also invite any Guild member who has photos they want to bring.
- Photos may only be selected by one Guild member so we do not have more than one
 piece of art inspired by a single photo. We tell the Guild members that rule, but will
 need the photographers to help us police that rule.
- Guild members have asked that the photos provided be of high quality (as opposed to photocopies) so they can accurately capture colors and details. The Guild members are asked to safeguard your photos.
- We will be providing the email addresses of any photographers who do not mind
 working with Guild members who are unable to attend the photo selection meeting.
 The photographer and the Guild member will work together to select a photo(s) and
 then report to Linda Foster the selection. Please let Linda Foster know if you want to be

- We have asked our Guild members to contact their photographers to return photos no later than August 31, especially if they have larger size photos, to give photo club members plenty of time to mat them for display in the Gallery.
- Participating photo club members are invited to the Guild 's September Guild meeting
 at The Peoples Bank, Lake Oconee Branch: Friday September 8 at 10:00 a.m. for the
 Big Reveal of art and photos. Photo club members will need to bring their photos to the
 meeting.
- Participating photo club members should bring the photos that inspired art to Barrel 118 located at 118 N. Jefferson Street, Eatonton on Friday September 8 (1-5) or Saturday September 9 (10-3) to be displayed in the Reception and Exhibition. Please note that you do not deliver your artwork to the Gallery as you have in the past.
- For the Reception and Exhibition, all photos should be 8x10 and must be matted (to no larger than11x14). (no frames). The mat must be secured on all four sides. The color of the mat is your decision. However, we have observed that photos matted in white tend to not stand out well when displayed on our white pallets and walls.
- Put your name and the title of the back of each photo.
- All photos must be for sale and the Gallery manager is happy to facilitate multiple sales
 of the same photo if you will make more copies or offer photos in different sizes. Sales
 of your work will carry a 35% commission. Take that into consideration when you price
 your work. In the past, photos have been priced anywhere from \$15 to over \$100.
 Pricing is your decision.

- The Dual Vision Reception will be Thursday September 14 from 5:00 to 7:30 at large, beautiful and historic Barrel 118 located at 118 N. Jefferson Ave, Eatonton. The reception is free and open to the public. Complimentary wine and refreshments will be served. Cocktails and beer will be offered for sale. Bring your friends and family and vote for Peoples Choice for favorite photo and favorite artwork. Please note that the reception is not at the Gallery this year.
- You can see the show at Barrel 118 on Friday September 15 from 11-5 and Saturday September 16 from 10-3. After September 16, we will move the show to the Gallery where it will be on display through October 27.
- Please mark your calendars to pick up your photos from the Gallery (a reminder will be sent) Friday October 27 between 11-5 or Saturday October 28 between 10-3.
